JOB TITLE Regional Imagery Manager

REPORTING TO Head of Imagery

WORKING HOURS 37.5 hours a week with 30 minutes unpaid lunch. Working week is Monday to

Saturday (some weekend working as required). Flexibility is important for photography appointments e.g. when convenient for potential owners.

PLACE OF WORK Office based (Whitby or Seahouses) with regular travel to properties for

photography visits across the region and to our offices as required. Other travel

further afield may be required e.g. for training or to cover other regions.

Role summary

We are looking for a passionate, creative and organized individual who will lead on imagery within their specified region. The Regional Imagery Manager will join the Imagery team alongside the other regional imagery managers reporting directly to the Head of Imagery and will focus on improving the quality of the property photography portfolio inline with the TOCC Photography Standards and Brand Guidelines, ensure our lifestyle, landscape and area imagery are of good quality and being used in the best way on our websites and other marketing materials.

You will be competitive and hungry to develop your skills and will be in constant communication with the rest of the imagery team and other regional photographers to gain knowledge and share skills etc. You will be expected to undertake the majority of photoshoots with support as required from other trained photography staff within the region as and when their time allows. With training, you will also be asked to help develop their photography skills.

This role requires intelligent planning and organisation to be as efficient and effective as possible. You will be supported by the imagery team with training and assistance as required. This is a desirable, enjoyable and rewarding role for the right person.

Note: frequent travel across your region will be required to fulfil the role tasks and objectives.

Key responsibilities

Photography

- Capturing our property portfolio in the best possible light inline with TOCC guidelines.
- Working alongside the processing team to ensure a quality final product is produced in line with the imagery turnaround time SLA.

• Shooting higher-end properties outside of standard shooting times ie. sunset/sunrise.

Scheduling and Organisation

- Organizing and managing property photography spreadsheets.
- Deciding on priorities and focusing on key business objectives.
- Managing homeowner expectations and scheduling photoshoots.
- Planning and organizing landscape, and area shoots to be cost-effective and efficient.
- Assist with the organization of any regionally specific lifestyle shoots.
- Assist with the organization of any regionally specific video shoots.
- Organize and arrange drone operations as and when required.
- Organize and arrange Matterport 3D scanning as and when required.

Training & Development

- Assisting the imagery team with the constant development of other photographers within your regions to assist with efficiency and quality improvement.
- Undertaking training sessions yourself to build upon your own skill sets (this may be in other regions).
- Attend monthly meetings with the imagery team.
